It was the year 2016, four years since I resigned from the teaching service. I had just graduated from School of Leadership at Tung Ling Bible School (TLBS), not knowing what my next steps were.

Then the clear voice of the Holy Spirit spoke to me that Pastor Henson was going to text me and I was to say yes to his requests. It was a clear voice of the Holy Spirit but I had dismissed it and not taken it seriously. Don't ask me why. Perhaps the instruction was too....specific? Behold, a few minutes after I heard the voice, Pastor Henson's text came, asking if I could share at an AAA (Awakened. Aligned. Assigned.) seminar my story of how God had used the Archippus Awakening message to impact me. My heart skipped a beat. I replied with "Yes!", adding that the Holy Spirit just told me to say yes to his requests. He said it was like a blank cheque given to him. My Aromatic Awakening!

I did not know how misaligned I was in my body, soul and spirit until I literally collapsed onto the floor.

After teaching for more than 15 years, I resigned and enrolled into TLBS. Upon graduation, I was headed to Cambodia for overseas missions, but I was stopped dead in my tracks by a rude shock.

I had arranged to meet my Bible school friends for dinner. I parked my car at level five of Plaza Singapura, opened the door and stepped out.

Suddenly, an excruciating pain hit my back. I could not stand up. The pain was so unbearable that I slumped to the floor. Lying on the ground helplessly, all I could manage to do was grab my phone to call my friends. When they found me, they called for an ambulance and I was wheeled to the A&E (Accident & Emergency) department. My friends told me later that a car had reversed into the empty lot next to mine. Had they not located me, I would have been crushed since I was in the driver's blind spot.

Thank God for preserving my life! I was diagnosed with a slipped disc, and that was when I began my wilderness journey. During my recuperation, I had no regular income but I had regular quiet time with God.

God showed me how misaligned my life had been. I was running on the performance treadmill and relying on my own strength to accomplish things. No wonder my body protested – I was burnt out. Having the luxury of time in my hands, one of the things I enjoyed doing was learning at different seminars.

I attended one organised by Archippus Awakening.

Now, something interesting happened two weeks before the seminar. A word was released to me that I would be given a new sense of smell – I would smell fragrance in the presence of His truth. And at the seminar I really smelled fragrance! God had my attention. And as I heard Pastor Henson, founder of Archippus Awakening, speak about being awakened, aligned and assigned, my spirit leapt in resonance!

God whispered to me that I was called out to be in alignment with what He wants to do in this season. I was to be anything but aimless. I wanted to finish strong and to be able to say I had done what God assigned me to do. I charged to the book table after the seminar and bought a copy of Say to Archippus. I devoured the book and got in touch with Pastor Henson after that, eventually attending a retreat to learn more.

As I focused on intimacy with God, my body began to recover, as my soul and spirit were restored. I also began to receive assignments from Him. God said to say no to teaching and yes to writing. That was challenging because I would have no regular income.

But as I learnt to obey Him, He encouraged me. When my second book Precious Moments in the Wilderness was published, I received encouraging reports of how the book had been a blessing. One email from a caregiver excited my heart: She was reading my teaching anecdotes from my first book Precious Moments of a Teacher to a 77-year-old retired lady suffering from dementia. Usually unresponsive, this lady began to move her hands and a

smile appeared on her face. The caregiver told me how encouraging it was to see her patient progress; she was prompted to write to encourage me. I knew in my heart then that God was affirming my obedience.

I also resolved to discern between kingdom assignments and Christian activities. In choosing kingdom assignments, I was experiencing unspeakable joy and a sense of purpose amidst challenges. Life becomes all about Christ and being intentional to fulfil kingdom purposes. Obedience is the key to unlock blessings.

I began to do things differently. I learnt to let God empower me and to work from a posture of rest. That meant having to completely trust Him and obey Him – not relying on my own strength or wisdom. God is my King, and I do what the King says. I have been awakened! I do not want to go back to sleep again.

Busyness is not fruitfulness. Faithfulness is key.

I am also thankful for a community of kingdom friends whom I can journey with and spur one another on to finish our race.

3 KEYS OF AWAKENING

- 1. Busyness is not fruitfulness. You can be busy but be busy with things of the kingdom.
- 2. After an awakening, remain awakened. Find a kingdom community. Spur one another on towards fulfilling kingdom assignments. You can be awakened and fall back to sleep.
- 3. Obedience unlocks blessings. Running on the performance treadmill exposes a lack of trust in God. Trust and obey God. He is King. What the King says, goes.

Jesus Calls Us by Name

One precious awakening moment for me was learning what this biblical character Archippus has to do with my kingdom assignment. Although Archippus is only mentioned twice in the Bible (Colossians 4:17 and Philemon 2), my former senior pastor at Grace Assembly of God, Pastor David Lim, had already preached on him before. In his sermon which he exhorted us to be obedient to what God has shown us, he used Paul as an example. Speaking of his conversion to King Agrippa, Paul said he was not disobedient to the heavenly vision (Acts 26:19), referring to his encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus (Acts 9:3-6). Then Pastor Lim directed us to Paul reminding Archippus in Colossians 4:17 to take heed to the ministry which he had received in the Lord, that he might fulfil it.

Hence, Archippus is not too obscure a character for me but God awakened me to know that like Archippus, I am almost anonymous but I am known to God by name, hence He has kingdom assignments for me.

The Holy Spirit began to teach me how powerful this is, being known to Him by name. He calls us by name!

Early in my career as a teacher, God had whispered into my ears a simple and powerful – yet easily neglected strategy to encourage my students when marking their assignments. He told me to always write their names accompanying affirmative remarks. So instead of just writing "Good job! Keep it up!", I was to write "Good job, Alvin! Keep it up!"

I remember receiving feedback from former pupils on how much those compliments meant to them. After all, there is just something about being called by name.

I was intrigued by this encounter between Mary Magdalene and her beloved Jesus (John 20:11-18).

As Mary stood outside by Jesus' tomb weeping, she stooped down to investigate the tomb. She saw two angels in white sitting, where the body of Jesus had lain, one at the head and the other at the feet.

They said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?"

She said to them, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."

Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but did not know that it was Jesus.

Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?"

Supposing that He was the gardener, Mary said to Jesus, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away."

Jesus said to her, "Mary!"

She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher)."

Before Jesus called her by name, Mary could not recognise Him. Perhaps she was overwhelmed with grief – she had been weeping – thinking that the

Romans had taken away Jesus' body and wondering where they had put Him. Even when Jesus spoke to her, the eyes of her heart did not open. She even assumed Him to be the gardener. She only recognised Him when He called her "Mary!"

In the same gospel of John, John had recorded Jesus' words: "I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own." (John 10:14)

"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand. I and My Father are one." (John10:27-30)

At "Mary!", her first response was "Rabboni!" She had recognised her Master's voice. The tone of His voice when He called her. That voice. She knew it.

According to Barnes' Notes on the Bible, Rabboni is a Hebrew word denoting, literally, my great master. It was one of the titles given to Jewish teachers.

This title was given under three forms:

- 1. Rab, master the lowest degree of honour.
- 2. Rabbi, my master a title of higher dignity.
- 3. Rabboni, my great master the most honourable of all.

Just like that, Jesus had gone from gardener to Great Master. Jesus calls us by name. He knows us intimately. He knows us personally. He has assignments for us.

- 3. Have you asked Him what your assignment is?
